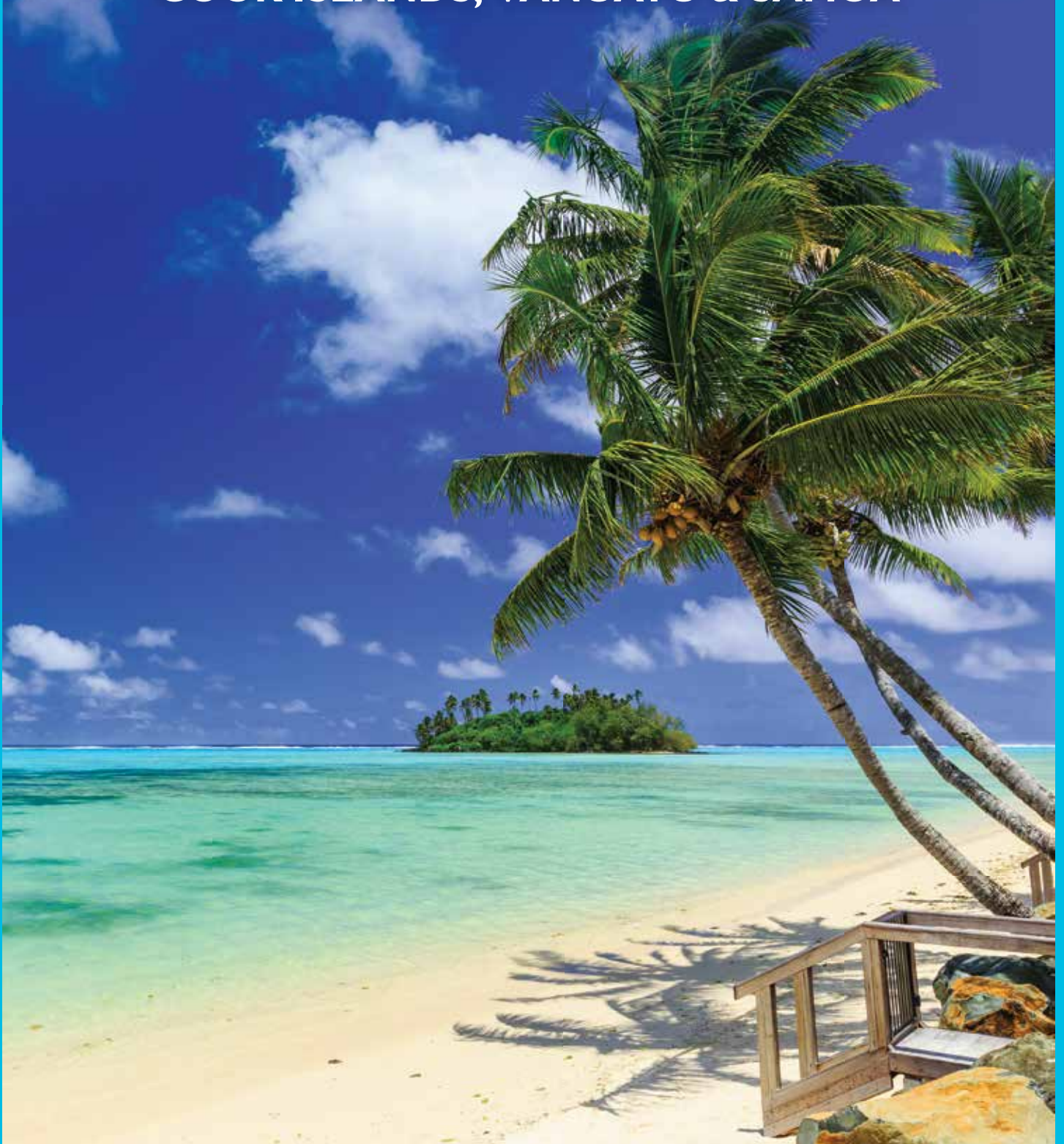

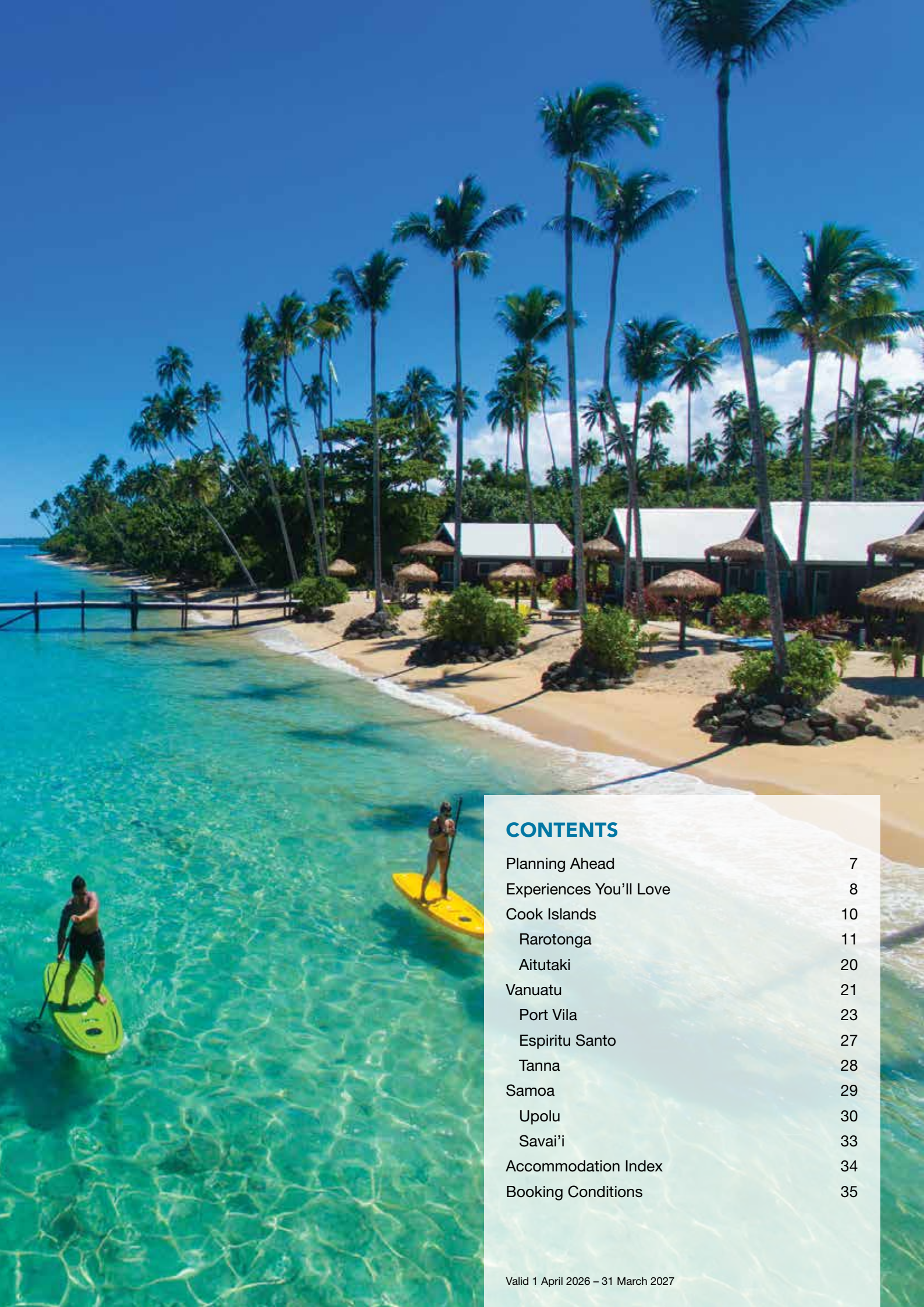

WHEN TO GO

In the South Pacific Islands, the drier months are from April to October, with less humidity and pleasant temperatures perfect for lounging on the beach. The calm, crystal clear waters also make this the best time for snorkelling and diving across the islands.

Temperatures in the South Pacific Islands are constant year-round, whilst the months of November to March can bring tropical showers and storms. This season is the best time get off the beaten path and see the spectacular waterfalls in full flow.

LANGUAGE

Cook Islands: Cook Islands Māori is the native language. English is widely spoken on the island of Rarotonga.

Vanuatu: French and Bislama (Pidgin English) are both spoken.

Samoa: Samoan is the official language. English is widely spoken in major tourist areas.

TIME

The Cook Islands are 20 hours behind Australian Eastern Standard time (AEST). Vanuatu is 1 hour ahead of AEST and Samoa is 3 hours ahead of AEST.

TIPPING & BARGAINING

Tipping is not expected, however leaving a small monetary gift for good service is always welcomed.

VISAS & PASSPORTS

All travellers to the South Pacific must carry a passport valid for at least six months beyond the date of departure from Australia. Tourist visas will be issued on arrival for stays up to 30 days in the Cook Islands, 120 days in Vanuatu and 90 days in Samoa. As visa information can change at any time, we recommend you seek advice regarding passports, visas, and other travel requirements at smartraveller.gov.au.

CURRENCY

Cook Islands: New Zealand dollar (NZD).
Vanuatu: Vanuatu Vatu (VUV).
Samoa: Samoan Tala (WST).

ATM's are located in urban areas across the South Pacific Islands but are not widely accessible in remote areas. Not all venues take card so it is always a good idea to carry some local cash on you.

SNORKELLING & DIVING

SURFING

WHALE WATCHING

Between the months of July and October Humpback whales migrate into the South Pacific from their summer feeding grounds of Australia and New Zealand. The migration patterns of these miraculous giants varies each year, but they can be seen throughout these months across the Cook Islands, Vanuatu and Samoa.
