TRAVEL TIPS

WHEN TO GO

Vietnam, Cambodia and Laos each offer year-round travel with warm tropical climates and unique seasonal highlights. In Vietnam, autumn in the north is crisp, while central beaches shine from February to August; southern Vietnam has a tropical climate and is warm year-round with dry season from December to April. Cambodia's dry season is from November to April while the green season, May to October brings cooler days and lush landscapes. Laos has a serene dry season from November to March while spring and summer months see renewed waterfalls and greener scenery.

VISAS & PASSPORTS

All travellers to Vietnam, Cambodia and Laos must carry a passport valid for at least six months beyond the date of departure from Australia and an electronic visa must be obtained prior to departure to these countries. As visa information can change at any time, we recommend you seek advice regarding passports, visas and other travel requirements for the countries you intend visiting from the Australian Government at smartraveller.gov.au.

TIME

Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia are three hours behind Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST).

ELECTRICITY

220-230V 50Hz. An adapter is required.

LANGUAGE

Vietnam: Vietnamese is the official language however English is widely spoken.

Laos: Lao is the official language and English is becoming widely spoken.

Cambodia: Khmer is the official language and English is becoming widely spoken.

CURRENCY

Vietnam: Dong (VND)

Laos: Kip (LAK)

Cambodia: Riel (KHR)

Major credit cards are widely accepted throughout major cities in Vietnam, while in Laos and Cambodia use of credit cards is limited. Cash is the preferred form of payment in smaller towns, markets and street vendors. In Laos, Thai Baht (THB) and US Dollars (USD) may also be accepted but generally only in tourist areas and major tourist establishments. In Cambodia, US Dollars are widely accepted but it is recommended that small denomination notes in good condition are used.

TIPPING

Tipping is not customary, however a token of appreciation is always welcome for good service.




GETTING AROUND

By Air

Flying between and within Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia is the most convenient option. Domestic flights within these countries can be arranged by your travel agent.

By Rail

Rail is a popular option when travelling within Vietnam. The most popular rail journey is from Hanoi to Lao Cai or Hue. Other rail options are available from Saigon to Phan Thiet, Da Nang, Hue and Hanoi. Alternatively, travel by rail between Nha Trang and Da Nang. Expect to travel in four-berth soft sleeper compartments on overnight journeys and economy airline style seating on day trips. Ask your travel agent for details.

MEKONG CRUISE 12 DAYS

Day 1: Ho Chi Minh City

On arrival in Ho Chi Minh City, you will be transferred to your hotel. Spend the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight at Emm Saigon Hotel (or similar).

Day 2: Hoi Chi Minh City to Can Tho (BL)

Today cruise on a traditional flat-bottomed sampan boat, passing floating markets and artisan workshops. Enjoy lunch by the water at Le Longanier Restaurant, located in a French-colonial villa before travelling to Can Tho. Overnight at Victoria Can Tho Resort (or similar).

Day 3: Can Tho (BD)

Spend the day at leisure exploring Can Tho. In the afternoon board the Victoria Mekong. Relax on board and enjoy a sunset cocktail while listening to Southern Vietnamese folk music. Stay the next seven nights on board the Victoria Mekong.

Day 4: Long Xuyen, via Tiger Island to Vam Nao (BLD)

Visit Long Xuyen Floating Market, explore artisanal crafts on Tiger Island, and see Mr. Tiger's Temple. Return to the boat for a lively cocktail-making competition before overnighting at Vam Nao.

Day 5: Vam Nao to Tan Chau (BLD)

Explore a traditional pottery village and see the artisans use the traditional clay stoves. Continue to Tan Chau village where a rickshaw ride offers glimpses into local life, from bustling markets to serene temples. Back onboard, enjoy a Vietnamese lion dance performance.

Day 6: Tan Chau to Phnom Penh (BLD)

Set course for Phnom Penh and enjoy onboard cultural activities. Finish the evening on board the ship with a Khmer Apsara dance performance.

Day 7: Phnom Penh (BLD)

This morning, take a cyclo tour and see the majestic Royal Palace and Silver Pagoda before spending time at the National Museum and Choeng Ek. Unwind with a signature cocktail, inspired by Jackie Kennedy's 1967 visit, at The Raffles Hotel's iconic Elephant Bar.

Day 8: Phnom Penh, via Koh Chen and Koh Dach to Angkor Ban (BLD)

After breakfast, join a walking tour of the village of Koh Chen. Visit Oudong, the ancient capital of Cambodia before travelling to Silk Island on a Tuk Tuk. Learn about the process of silk weaving and observe local families weaving the iconic Cambodian krama.

Day 9: Angkor Ban to Kampong Cham (BLD)

Today explore the village of Angkor Ban with its traditional stilt houses. Cruise to Kampong Cham where you will join an afternoon walking tour of the town.

Day 10: Kampong Cham to Siem Reap (BL)

Arrive in Siem Reap, where you'll be welcomed and transferred to the hotel. Stay the next two nights at Baitong Heritage Hotel, Siem Reap (or similar).

Day 11: Angkor Temple (BL)

Today journey to at Angkor Thom's South Gate before visiting Bayon Temple. Continue on to the iconic Ta Prohm temple, where large trees entwine the stone. In the afternoon, explore Angkor Wat. Finish with a sunset at Pre Rup temple, a large tiered pyramid structure that offers impressive panoramic views of the landscape.

Day 12: Banteay Srei and Banteay Samre (B)

Travel through the countryside to two of the most interesting temples outside Angkor – Banteay Srei and Banteay Samre. Surrounded by a moat, Banteay Srei features delicately carved pink sandstone bas-reliefs depicting scenes of daily life. Banteay Samre built in the early 12th century is a Hindu temple. In the afternoon, transfer to the airport.

VIETNAM & CAMBODIA DISCOVERY 14 DAYS

Day 1: Hanoi (D)

On arrival in Hanoi, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. This evening, enjoy a live cooking demonstration before savouring a dinner showcasing Vietnamese cuisine. Stay the next two nights at Flower Garden Hanoi Hotel (or similar).

Day 2: Hanoi (B)

Discover Hanoi's sites on a half day tour. Visit the Ho Chi Minh Complex and see the tranquil Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first university.

Day 3: Hanoi to Ha Long Bay (BLD)

Travel to Ha Long Bay to cruise the impressive emerald waters. After lunch, stop at Ti Top Island and choose to hike up the mountain or take a refreshing swim. Overnight on board Emeraude Classic.

Day 4: Ha Long Bay to Hue (B)

Take part in a sunrise yoga session on deck before exploring the natural splendour of Sung Sot Cave. After brunch, transfer to Hanoi train station for your overnight rail journey to Hue.

Day 5: Hue (B)

Spend the day discovering the sites of Phnom Penh. Visit the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda and the National Museum. Spend time at Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum before visiting Phnom Penh's central market.

After breakfast, drive to Siem Reap, stopping at Spider Town and Kampong Kdei to see the ancient bridge. Stay the next three nights at Angkor Holiday Hotel, Siem Reap (or similar).

VIETNAM, CAMBODIA & LAOS HIGHLIGHTS 17 DAYS

Day 1: Hanoi

On arrival in Hanoi, be transferred to your hotel. Stay the next two nights at Flower Garden Hanoi Hotel (or similar).

Day 2: Hanoi (B)

During a half day city tour, see cultural and historical highlights, including the Temple of Literature, Quan Thanh Temple and Tran Quoc Pagoda.

Day 3: Hanoi to Mai Chau (B)

Travel to Mai Chau and spend the day at leisure in this scenic village. Overnight at Mai Chau Lodge (or similar).

Day 4: Mai Chau to Hanoi (B)

Enjoy free time before transferring back to Hanoi. Overnight at Flower Garden Hanoi Hotel (or similar).

Day 5: Ha Long Bay To Hue (BL)

Start the day with a visit to central park and the vibrant flower market. Stop at an age-old coffee shop for a traditional Vietnamese coffee experience.

Day 11: Ho Chi Minh City to Siem Reap (B)

Fly to Siem Reap and transfer to the hotel. Spend the remainder of the day at leisure. Stay the next three nights at Angkor Holiday, Siem Reap (or similar).

Day 12: Siem Reap (B)

Today visit the intricately carved temples of Banteay Srei and Banteay Samre.

Day 13: Temples of Angkor (B)

See the many Temples of Angkor on a full day tour. Explore Angkor Thom, Ta Prohm, and Angkor Wat, finishing with sunset views at Pre Rup Temple.

Day 14: Siem Reap to Luang Prabang (B)
