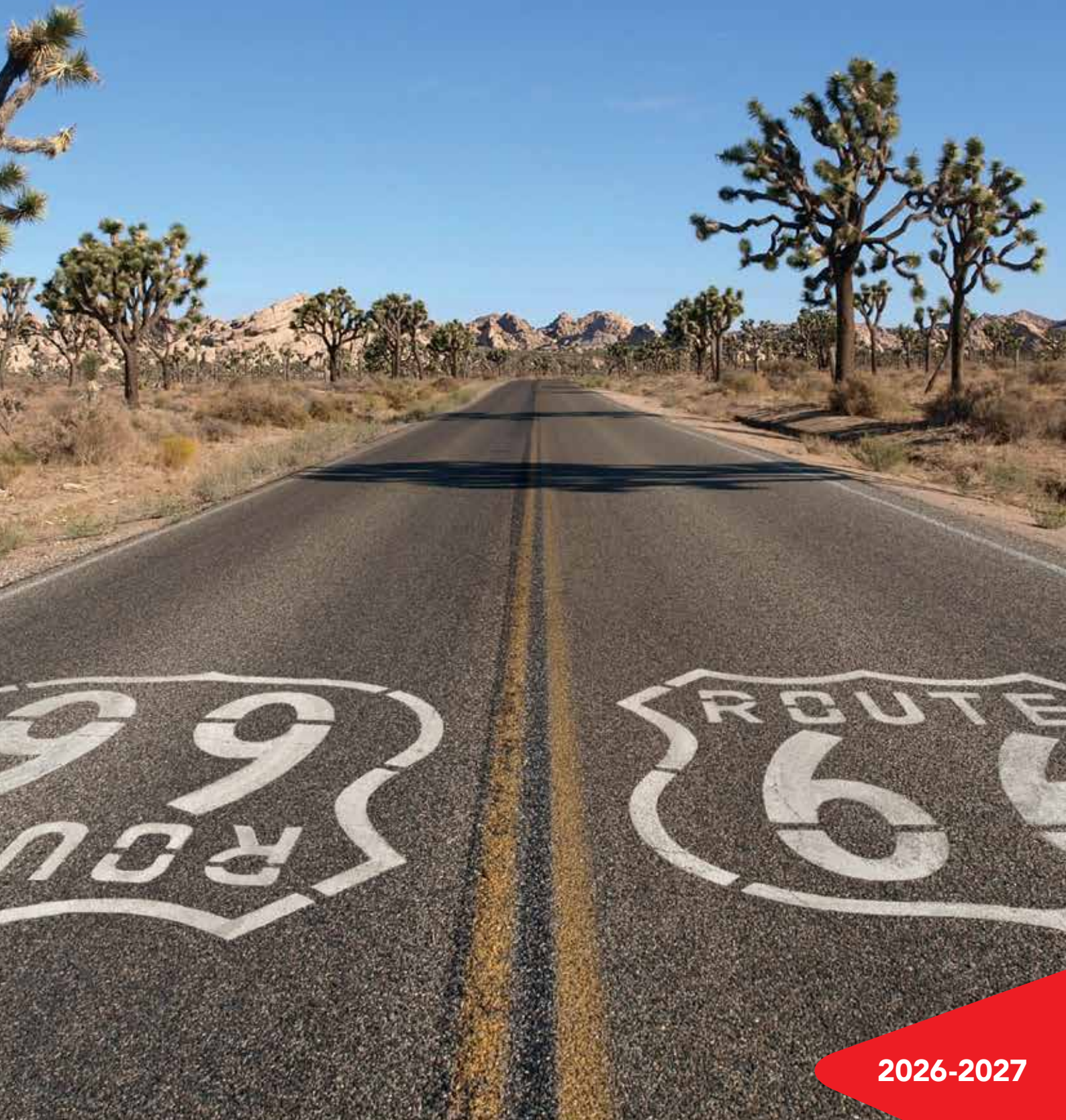

Day 1: San Francisco

Arrive in San Francisco and transfer independently to your hotel. Spend the next three nights in San Francisco.

Day 2: San Francisco

WESTERN TRAILS 8 DAYS

Day 1: Los Angeles

deep colourful plunging gorges and rising spires, formed by the mighty Colorado River. Overnight in the Grand Canyon.

Day 4: Grand Canyon via Monument Valley to Page

Today journey to the Navajo Indian Reservation, passing the trading post of Cameron. Continue through the Painted Desert to visit Monument Valley. This area embodies perhaps the most iconic images of the American West. In the late afternoon, arrive at Page situated on a mesa above the Colorado River. Spend the evening at leisure. Overnight in Page.

Day 5: Page via Kanab to Bryce Canyon (B)

Visit the mighty Glen Canyon Dam, the second highest concrete arch dam in America. Admire the stunning views of Lake Powell, where crystal blue water laps against towering red rock canyon walls. Arrive in Utah, best known for its Mormon community, and pass through the town of Kanab, before visiting spectacular Bryce Canyon National Park. This evening, weather permitting, gaze upon the spectacular night sky filled with sparkling stars and brilliant constellations. Overnight in Bryce Canyon.

Day 6: Bryce Canyon via Zion National Park to Las Vegas (B)

Travel to Zion National Park, Utah's oldest national park and see the massive rock formations carved by the Virgin River. This afternoon arrive at Las Vegas, the dazzling 'Entertainment Capital of the World'. Try your luck at one of the many casinos, stroll along the famous Strip or take in one of the nightly cabaret shows. Spend the next two nights in Las Vegas.

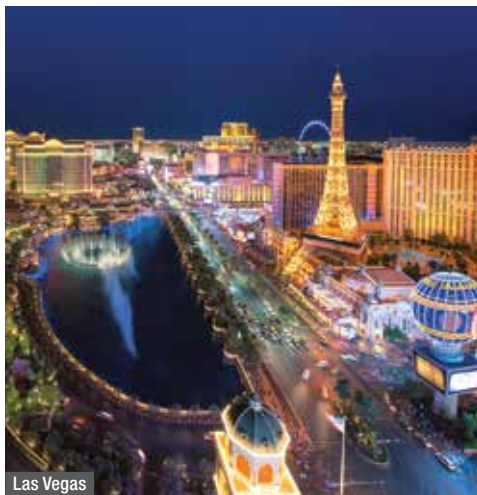

This morning take an optional scenic gondola ride to the summit of Mammoth. Enjoy a delicious breakfast as you marvel at the stunning views of California from its desert floor to its lofty peaks (extra charge). Then cross the Tioga Pass into the scenic wonderland of Yosemite National Park.

Experience the splendour of the valley floor including the glacial-shaped granite formations of El Capitan, Half Dome, the magnificent Bridalveil Fall and Yosemite Falls. Overnight in nearby Modesto.

Day 5: Modesto to San Francisco

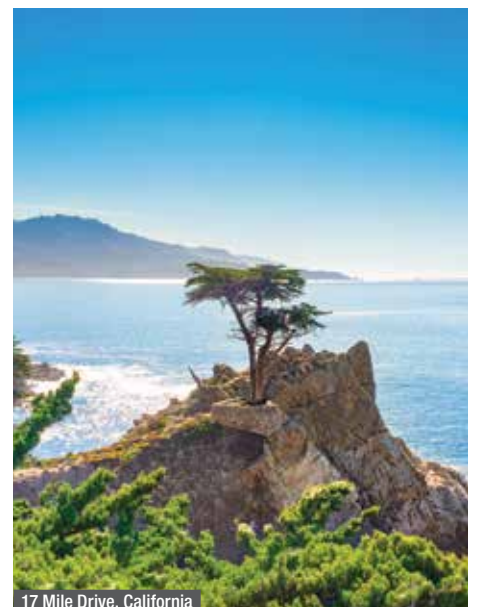

Day 1: San Francisco

On arrival at San Francisco International Airport make your own way to your hotel. Spend the next two nights in San Francisco.

Day 2: San Francisco

This morning enjoy a half day city tour of San Francisco. See Union Square, the Civic Centre and the Golden Gate Bridge. Enjoy the spectacular view from Twin Peaks. Spend the afternoon at leisure, exploring the 'City by the Bay'. Perhaps take a cable car ride to Fisherman's Wharf and sample local seafood dishes as you gaze across the bay to Alcatraz.

Day 3: San Francisco to Fresno

Travel to Yosemite National Park, renowned for magnificent waterfalls, granite peaks and unique wildlife. Explore the park by motorcoach, admiring the stunning scenery and but you will also have time on the valley floor to enjoy the spectacular scenery. Overnight in Yosemite Getway.

Day 4: Fresno via Mojave Desert to Las Vegas

Drive through the Mojave Desert and see the indigenous Joshua trees, on your way to Las Vegas. Spend the remainder of the day taking in the sights and sounds of the 'Entertainment Capital of the World'. See the dancing fountains at the Bellagio, stroll along the famous strip or see a show. Alternatively, join an evening tour of Las Vegas (extra charge). Spend the next two nights in Las Vegas.

Day 5: Las Vegas

The day is yours to enjoy in Las Vegas. Maybe do a little shopping at one of the fine shopping outlets in Las Vegas, lounge by the pool, or join an optional tour to Death Valley National Park (extra cost), the lowest (below sea level) and hottest region in the western hemisphere.

Day 6: Las Vegas via Cedar City to Bryce Canyon

Continue the adventure as you travel north bound through the Mojave Desert. For the next couple of days you'll visit the Colorado Plateau, home to several national parks including our destination today, Bryce Canyon. Enjoy the spectacular views of Bryce and Inspiration Point where you see how the canyon is filled with numerous Hoodoos, a Pillar of Rock. Join Ebenezer's dinner show for an evening of country music and local cuisine (extra cost). Overnight in Bryce Canyon.

Day 7: Bryce Canyon via Grand Canyon to Williams

After leaving Bryce Canyon travel through the community of Kanab, where at one time the movie industry was alive and cowboys like Roy Rogers, John Wayne, and Ronald Reagan. Enter the Navajo Indian Reservation, where this ancient culture remains through today a fascinating one. Visit the Grand Canyon National Park, one of the 7 natural wonders of the world.

Consult your Tour Director about a helicopter flight above the canyon (extra cost). Overnight in the historic Route 66 community of Williams.

Day 8: Williams via Seligman-Route 66 to Bullhead City

After experiencing historic Williams, stop in one of last remain historic towns, Seligman. If souvenir shopping is on your mind, this is where you find them ranging from road signs to T-shirts displaying the history of the Route.
